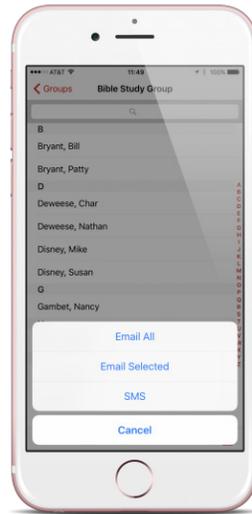
News On New Releases: CDM+ 10 and CDM+ Mobile 1.8 Will Be Available On October 12

The Annual Users Conference gave attendees a first look at the next releases of CDM+ software for desktop and mobile devices. **CDM+ 10** was previewed in detail in the last issue of *The CDM+ Connection*, which you can read [here](#). The new version of **CDM+ Mobile 1.8** was introduced at the conference by Development Manager Alex Clay. Both are scheduled for release on October 12, and both are designed to help you foster connections with and between members by tapping into innovative technologies and integrated features in your CDM+ database.

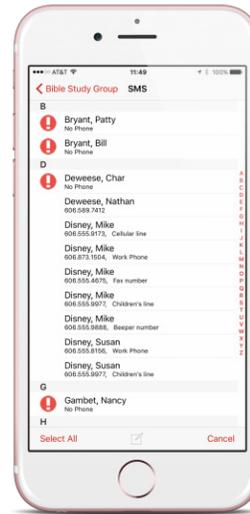
CDM+ MOBILE 1.8

CDM+ Mobile already allows you to send email from a mobile device to contacts in your CDM+ database. **CDM+ Mobile 1.8** will allow you to also send Personal SMS text messages using your phone's messaging service. The Personal SMS messages will appear as having originated from your mobile phone number and can be personalized for each recipient. This is ideal for church leaders who wish to communicate a quick reminder, a last-minute change notice, or a personal prayer request to all of the members of a specific group. Changing the location of tomorrow's volunteer meeting? A text message may reach everyone faster than email and more reliably than a social media post.

Personal SMS messaging is not intended as a means to communicate with your entire church body. There are lots of reasons why you wouldn't want to send

hundreds of texts at once to every mobile number in your database, most notably that your service provider probably wouldn't like it! So, it's important for us to note here that these personal SMS messages are sent using your cell phone plan and count toward any texting limits imposed under your plan.

In addition to the personal SMS feature, **CDM+ Mobile 1.8** has some "under-the-hood" improvements that should give users a more stable and more resilient mobile experience, especially on Android devices and for anyone with spotty mobile internet connectivity. The app is free, included with a Data Hosting subscription, and will be available for download October 12 in the App Store, at Amazon, and on Google Play.

CDM+ Mobile 1.8 works with any device running iOS 7.0 or higher or Android 4.0 or later. Your device must be able to connect to the Internet in order to access your hosted CDM+ database, and phone/internet carrier restrictions may apply. For existing users of CDM+ Mobile, the 1.8 version will work with your CDM+ 9.3.6 configuration. However, once you're ready to upgrade to **CDM+ 10**, you will also need to have your mobile users update to **CDM+ Mobile 1.8** on their devices.
